Our fees are set in accordance with the CEWA Ltd School Fee Policy. We take into account the anticipated level of State and Australian Government Grants and incorporate all items known to be an integral part of the curriculum. All fees are reviewed annually prior to the commencement of the new school year.

School fees are invoiced at the start of each school year and to assist families with the payment of their fees, St Benedict's School offers multiple payment options.

A sibling discount is applied to the full tuition fee component for siblings attending the school at the same time however, does not include 3 Year Old Kindergarten students.

Booklists

- 4 Year Old Kindergarten and Pre-Primary – Booklist costs are included in your annual fees. This allows the teacher to purchase necessary class items over the school year.
- Years 1 - 6 Booklist items will need to be purchased by parents. A booklist will be given to each year group (Yrs 1 – 6) and can be found on the school website.
- Years 3 – 6 iPad – 1:1 Bring your own device. The school utilises iPads and further details are available upon enrolment.

Other Expected Costs

Parents & Friends Association

Families of St Benedict's are invited to participate in fundraising activities and community building projects to enrich the school community and our social justice outreach objectives. All families have a P & F Levy included in their fees.

Application Fee

To commence the enrolment process, a non-refundable fee of \$55 per application is payable upon submission of the Student Enrolment Application. This fee does not guarantee an interview or position at the school.

Confirmation of Enrolment Fee

Upon acceptance of a position at St Benedict's, a non-refundable enrolment fee of \$500 is required. This will be credited to your school fees once your child has commenced at St Benedict's (excludes the 3 Year Old Kindergarten program).

Full Fee-Paying Overseas Students

Some overseas students may not be eligible for State and Federal funding. In this case the following fees will also apply. Details of current visa and eligibility can be discussed with the Finance Officer.

4 Year Old Kindergarten students \$4 325 p.a.

Pre-Primary to Year 6 Students \$8 932 p.a.

Health Care Card Concession

To be eligible, families require a Family Health Care Card or a Pensioner Concession Card in the name of the parent/guardian responsible for payment of the school fees. This discount applies on tuition fees and the Building Levy.

Concessions can only be applied within the dates the card is valid. Please contact the school Finance Officer to determine eligibility and to complete the application form.

The aim of this scheme are twofold, to reduce the financial burden on families with limited financial resources and to reduce the financial barrier that prevents Catholic families from accessing a Catholic Education.

The School Principal has the final authority to apply any discount via the Health Care Card Concession Program.

Payment Options & Methods

Fee Statements for the school year will be forwarded to parents at the beginning of the school term.

Preferred method of payment is by direct debit from Bank Account or Credit Card.

The School offers the following payment options:

Option 1	Annual payment	Due 28 March
Option 2	3 Instalments	10 March, 10 June & 10 September
Option 3	9 Instalments	10 March to 10 November

A new payment plan needs to be completed each year and no arrangements will be carried over from previous years. All fees are to be finalised by 10 November each year.

Any payment arrangements outside the tabled options need to be approved by the Principal.

Financial Difficulties

If you are experiencing genuine financial difficulties for any reason, please contact the school Finance Officer to discuss suitable arrangements. The school does reserve the right to recover outstanding debts in accordance with the CEWA Ltd School Fee Policy.

Withdrawal of Students

Notice of withdrawal can only be given in writing to the Principal. At least one full term must be given prior to the removal of a student. Failure to provide this notice will result in the charge of one term's tuition fee. Verbal notification will not be accepted.
